This bulletin reports on the Authority's meeting held on 31 March 2006.

Chair's Report

ECS presented her report. The following matters were discussed:

- ECS congratulated John Walter Jones on his appointment as the new Chair of S4C and she wished him well in his new job.
- The Authority members expressed their appreciation to Elan for her leadership and they wished her well.
- Following Dafydd Wigley's decision to stand down as board member to S4C, Elan expressed her appreciation to Dafydd as a Board member and also his thoroughness as Chair to the Audit Committee. Decision needs to be taken whether an additional member is needed to the Board and also Chair to the Audit Committee.
- ECS reported on the Voice of the Listener and Viewer conference.

Complaints and Viewers Hotline Report

Replies from ITV and S4C have been received regarding "*Y Byd ar Bedwar*" / Gwynedd County Council complaint and EM now awaits a reply from the Council by 13 April.

Report on the system of Complaints and Compliance

A report on S4C's Complaints and Compliance system was presented. Following the Complaints Committee earlier that morning, it was agreed in principle that changes needed to be made to the S4C's Complaints Code, and the changes in the wording should be simplified and outlined clearer to the public.
