Trystan ac Emma yn mynd yn ôl i'r ysgol

Wythnos yma bydd tîm **Prospect Pum Mil** yn mynd yn ôl i'r ysgol i helpu dosbarth y chweched Ysgol y Creuddyn, Llandudno i greu gofod arbennig i orffwys, gweithio a chwarae!

Mae Ysgol y Creuddyn yn gwasanaethu ardal y glannau o Benmaenmawr i Abergele ac ardaloedd cefn gwlad fel Llangernyw a Llansannan. "Mae'n ysgol sy'n dipyn mwy nag oedd o pan wnaeth o agor a'r gobaith ydy mai tyfu byddwn ni wrth symud ymlaen i'r blynnyddoedd nesas," meddai'r penneth Trefor Jones.

Yn ôl Mr Jones, mae tua 80 o staff yn dysgu 650 o ddisgyblion gyda 110 o'r rhain yn y chweched dosbarth.

A disgyblion y chweched dosbarth sydd wedi gofyn i Trystan Ellis Morris a Emma Walford, sy'n gyn-disgybl o Ysgol y Creuddyn, am help y gyfres **Prospect Pum Mil** ar S4C i adnewyddu dwy ystafell - un fawr ac un fach - sydd gan y myfyrwyr ar hyn o bryd i weithio ac ymlacio.

"Mae'r 'stafell fawr jysd yn 'stafell lle da ni'n mynd i wneud bob dim rili - gwaith ysgol a chymdeithasu," meddai Ifan, un o'r disgyblion. "Y peth cynta' hoffwn i newid yw bod mwy o *split* rhwng ardal ymlacio ac ardal gwaith."

Meddai Beth, un o'r disgyblion eraill: "Dwi'n teimlo ar y funud bod o'n edrych wedi blino ac oherwydd hynna, da ni ddim yn cael ein cymhelli i wneud unrhyw fath o waith - dyw e ddim yn ardal delfrydol rili."

Mae ystafell fechan drws nesa lle mae'r disgyblion yn mynd i wneud gwaith unigol sydd hefyd angen bach o sylw'r tîm.

Fe fydd y disgyblion yn cynnig help llaw ac yn gweithio'n galed (gyda help y gymuned ehangach) i wireddu'r prosiect.

Gyda help y cynllunydd crefftus Gwyn Eiddior a dim ond £5000 o gyllid mae Emma a Trystan yn crwydro'r gymuned yn chwilio am wirfoddolwyr brwd a chwmnïau lleol gall helpu gyda'r prosiect.

Meddai Gwyn: "Pan ddes i weld chweched Ysgol y Creuddyn, fy argraff gyntaf oedd pa mor ddigalon a digysur ydy ystafelloedd y chweched. Yr her i fi yw rhoi rhywfaint o hapusrwydd yna a chreu lle mwy clud."

It's back to school for Trystan ac Emma

This week, the **Prosiect Pum Mil** team is going back to school to help the sixth form at Ysgol y Creuddyn in Llandudno to create a special space for the pupils to work, rest and play.

Ysgol y Creuddyn catchment area stretches from Penmaenmawr to Abergelie on the coast and into the countryside to towns including Llangernyw and Llansannan. "It's a school which is quite a lot bigger than it was when it first opened and the hope is that we will grow as we move on into the future," said head teacher Trefor Jones.

According to Mr Jones, the school has a staff of around 80 who teach 650 pupils with 110 of these in the sixth form.

And it is the pupils of the sixth form who have asked Trystan Ellis Morris and Emma Walford, a former pupil at the school, for the help of the **Prosiect Pum Mil** series on S4C to transform two rooms – one big and one small – which the students have at the moment to work and relax.

"The big room is just somewhere we go to do everything, really – school work and socialising," said Ifan, one of the pupils. "The first thing I'd like to change is to make more of a split between the work area and the relaxation area."

Another student, Beth, said: "I feel that it looks a bit tired at the moment and because of this, it doesn't encourage us to do any sort of work – it's not an ideal space, really."

There is a small room next door where the students go to do individual work which also needs a bit of a revamp.

The pupils will be offering a helping hand and be working hard (with the support of the local community) to make the project a success.

With the assistance of talented designer Gwyn Eiddior and a £5,000 budget, Emma and Trystan go around the area looking for keen volunteers and local companies who can help with the project.

Gwyn said: "When I went to see the sixth form at Ysgol y Creuddyn, my first impression was how miserable and uncomfortable the sixth form rooms are. The challenge for me is to inject a bit of cheer and to create a more cosy space."

What will be the reaction of the sixth formers and teachers at Ysgol y Creuddyn? Will the **Prosiect Pum Mil** team get full marks for their work at the end of the project?
