Dear Teachers of Wales,

After 15 years of working in education as a teacher and Deputy Head in the primary sector, I've began my role as Diversity, Sustainability and Social Purpose Leader for S4C.

Through my role as a teacher and Deputy Head, I received some training on diversity and antiracist behaviour but I, like many of you, am on a learning journey to improve my understanding of the experiences of the protected characteristics groups.

At times, the journey can be difficult, especially when trying to learn and discuss without causing any harm and ensuring that you don't use the wrong language and terminology.

I've been in meetings over the years where people from the same protected characteristics group disagree on terminology and language.

As a gay person, there are terms within the community that I don't like because of negative experiences I've had. But what's vitally important is that we do discuss and educate all our pupils on the positive and less positive experiences of our Ethnically Diverse Communities in Wales so that we can make Wales a safe and enjoyable place for all.

By following the 5 class activities, I hope that you feel that there is linguistic support for all of you and that you develop the confidence to openly discuss and question ethnicity with your pupils.
